

Tips for a Fabulous Rosa Wang Photo Shoot!

Get ready for an amazing experience! By the time the shoot is done, you won't believe how beautiful you feel! To get the most out of the shoot, see the tips below.

How far in advance should I book?

It's best to have your shoot about 4 weeks before any special occasion. This gives lots of time for photo retouching, deciding on your favourites and printing!

Before the shoot:

- Don't schedule too many appointments on the day of the shoot so we can relax and enjoy the experience!
- If you get a manicure or pedicure, remember that nail colour should be neutral.
- Bring any items you want to use to personalize your photos.

The day of the shoot:

- Arrive with your hair the way you want to wear it in the photo shoot
- Arrive in loose fitting clothing and jewellery so that you don't have any marks on your skin from tight bra straps, socks, jeans, watches, etc.
- Come a little earlier so we can have a cup of tea and get acquainted before we start the shoot.
- I'll do your makeup so that it will work with the lighting during the shoot.
- You'll be comfortable in a completely private setting, working with a female photographer.
- We'll work at a reasonable pace with breaks for makeup, clothing and set changes.

After the shoot:

- I will retouch your pictures myself to smooth your skin and to apply any special effects we've agreed on.
- I will print any pictures you choose in-house. No-one else will see them.
- We'll make arrangements for delivering your gorgeous pictures to you.

I'm afraid I won't look good in my photos

Relax! With flattering poses, makeup, lighting and photo retouching, you will look stunning in your photos. In addition to smoothing out your skin, I can remove scars and stretch marks and even fine tune your size and shape if that's what you want! You'll be thrilled with the results!

I'm nervous

Don't worry, my philosophy is that a comfortable experience, results in the best pictures. You'll be in my private studio with me as your photographer. I pride myself on my ability to put my clients at ease during the shoot.

Who will see my pictures?

What type of shoot is right for me?

What should I bring?

For a personality shoot, you can bring anything you want to personalize your photograph: your sports equipment, your favourite novel, a musical instrument.

For a boudoir shoot, bring any jewellery, lingerie and shoes (e.g., strappy sandals) that you want to wear to personalize the pictures.

If you're a bride to be, you're welcome to bring your wedding and honeymoon lingerie and your wedding accessories such as your veil, tiara and jewellery. You can even bring an item from your groom's wardrobe, such as a shirt or a tie – anything that makes the shoot more personal to him.

How long will I be at the studio?

This depends on which type of shoot you have selected. In general, you can expect to spend 2-4 hours.

How much should I budget for?

\$300 +. You never know how many photos you will want because they all are so beautiful!

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
